A8 Countries

Nationals of the EU countries of Latvia, Slovakia, the Czech Republic, Lithuania, Slovenia, Estonia, Hungary and Poland can live and work in the UK. These countries are referred to as the 'A8 countries'. However, the government's Worker Registration Scheme (WRS) monitors the participation of nationals of these EU countries in the UK labour market.

Unless exempt, an A8 worker should apply to register under the Worker Registration Scheme with the Home Office within one month of starting work for you. They will need to provide evidence of their employment (letter or contract) as part of the application and a £70 fee, unless they already have a certificate of registration.
