## 1. Introduction

This Statement sets out the terms, conditions, and associated charges under which SP Manweb Ltd. provides Metering Services within its licensed distribution area. It is prepared in accordance with Condition 36 of the Electricity Distribution Licence issued under the Electricity Act 1989 (as amended). Charges shown are exclusive of VAT and are reviewed annually.

Meter Point Administration Services (in accordance with the Retail Energy Code) are not covered by this Statement. Our Statement of Charges for Meter Point Administration Services can be downloaded from:

## 2. Eligibility to Apply for Metering Services

SP Manweb will offer terms for Basic Meter Asset Provision and Metering Point Administration Services within its distribution area, in line with its obligations. Certain non-half-hourly basic metering services must be provided as required under the form of the licence in force as of 1 June 2003.

## 3. Appointment and De-Appointment

SP Manweb's obligation to provide legacy metering services does not apply at any metering point where the Supplier has de-appointed the Distribution Network Operator as the Meter Asset Provider.

## 4. Services Offered by SP Manweb

Where SP Manweb provides Metering Services, charges are levied on the registered electricity supplier. Charges are calculated in accordance with methodologies set out in this Statement and the Distribution Licence.

## 5. Basis of Charges for Meter Asset Provision

Meter Asset Provision covers the supply of a certified meter and associated equipment. Charges apply on a pence-per-meter-per-MPAN-per-day basis and are billed monthly, based on meter counts taken on the 15th day of each month.

Payment terms are 30 days for meter asset provision charges and 14 days for transaction-based charges unless agreed otherwise.

## 6. Urgent Metering Services

If SPM provides an Urgent Metering Service in response to a supply interruption caused by a meter fault, charges will apply. These charges will be calculated on a time-and-materials basis and will reflect whether the work is carried out during normal working hours or outside normal working hours.
