- ✓ the prevention or relief of poverty and the relief of those in need by reason of disability or other disadvantage
- ✓ the advancement of citizenship and community development

THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

We will not provide funding for:

- ✗ Projects that take place outside of the United Kingdom
- ✗ General appeals and circulars including contributions to endowment funds
- ✗ Marketing appeals or fundraising activities
- ✗ Medical Research
- ✗ Travel or expeditions
- ✗ Projects which are primarily or exclusively intended to promote political or religious beliefs

CRITERIA

What period will the funding cover?

We will only approve funding for a one year period. Your project should commence during the relevant funding year and be completed within 12 months. We will not automatically award continuation of funding into subsequent years; however you are welcome to submit a new application, which will be considered alongside all other applications.

How much funding can you apply for?

We will hold more than one round of funding during the year. For the current round of funding we encourage applications ranging from £25,000 - £250,000. Subsequent rounds in the same year will be primarily for applications under £25,000.



HOW TO APPLY

If your organisation is eligible to apply, and your application will address at least one of the Foundation's themes and meets the criteria, you are welcome to submit an application.

All applications must be made through the online application form on our website. A read only version is also available to view on our website, so that you can see all of the information you will need before completing the online form. You can save your progress and go back to your application at a later date if you need to.

Supporting documentation

You will be required to upload a copy of your most recent Annual Report and Accounts, which should have been independently examined or audited.

If you have other information which you feel may be relevant, such as a Feasibility Study, Business Plan or Evaluation, please refer to it in your application so that we can request a copy if required.

We may also ask to see a copy of a recent bank statement.

Deadline and next steps

The deadline for submitting your application will be stated on our website. Applications received by the deadline will be screened for eligibility and completeness before going forward for consideration by the Trustees at their next meeting. The decision of the Trustees is final, and all applicants will be notified of the outcome in due course. Due to the high volume of applications that we receive, we are unable to provide individual feedback.

Please note; should your application be successful, a representative from your organisation will be required to attend an initial project planning session in January.
